Examination Scheme for Undergraduate Courses

1. Examination Scheme

Examination evaluation scheme for all courses shall follow the pattern of:

- **40% weightage for Continuous Internal Assessment (CIA)**
- **60% weightage for Semester End Examination (SEE)**

2. Slandered of Passing

The students to pass a course shall have to obtain a minimum of 40% marks in aggregate for each course where the course consists of Continuous Internal Assessment and Semester End Examination. The students shall obtain minimum of 40% marks in the Continuous Internal Assessment and 40% marks in Semester End Examination separately.

3. CIA Scheme for Courses Carrying more than 2 Credits

The CIA component for courses carrying more than 2 credits shall consist of the following assessment components:

a) Written Test Examination–20 Marks

A written test shall be conducted as a part of CIA evaluation. The marks secured in the test shall be proportionately converted to **10 marks**.

b) Online Quiz–10 Marks

An online quiz shall be conducted through the **Teach Us Application** by the respective departments. The conduct of the quiz shall be monitored by the Examination Committee of TCSC.

c) Departmental Assessment – 20 Marks

The departmental assessment component may include various evaluation methods **ANY TWO** of the followings:

- Field Visit
- Case Study
- Group Discussion
- PowerPoint Presentation
- Assignment and Viva-Voce

The departmental assessment shall be carried out by the respective departments under the supervision and guidance of the concerned HOD/Coordinators.

4. CIA Scheme for Courses Carrying 2 Credits

The CIA component for courses carrying 2 credits shall consist of the following assessment components:

a) Written Examination–20 Marks

A written test shall be conducted as a part of CIA evaluation. The marks secured in the test shall be proportionately converted to **10 marks**.

b) Online Quiz – 10 Marks

An online quiz shall be conducted through the Teach Us Application by the respective departments under the supervision of the Examination Committee of TCSC.

5. Provision for Additional CIA Examination

No additional CIA examination shall be conducted for students who remain absent or do not participate in any CIA evaluation component.

6. ATKT Examination Scheme

a) Courses carrying more than 2 credits:

The Written Examination carrying **40 marks (20 marks Objective type questions and 20 marks Descriptive questions)** shall be conducted by the Examination Department.

b) Courses carrying 2 credits:

The Written Examination carrying **20 marks (10 marks Objective type questions and 10 marks Descriptive questions)** shall be conducted by the Examination Department.

Semester End Examination

There shall be one Semester End Examination (SEE) in each semester for every theory course and shall be conducted at the end of semester.

Provision for Additional Semester End Examination

Additional Semester End examination shall be conducted for students as per the standard rule of University of Mumbai.
