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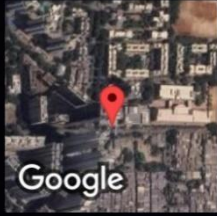

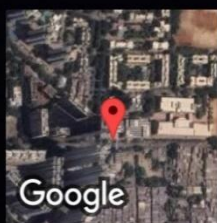


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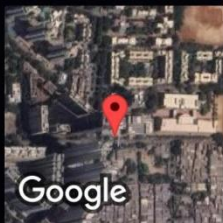
REPORT ON 'INDEPENDENCE DAY'.

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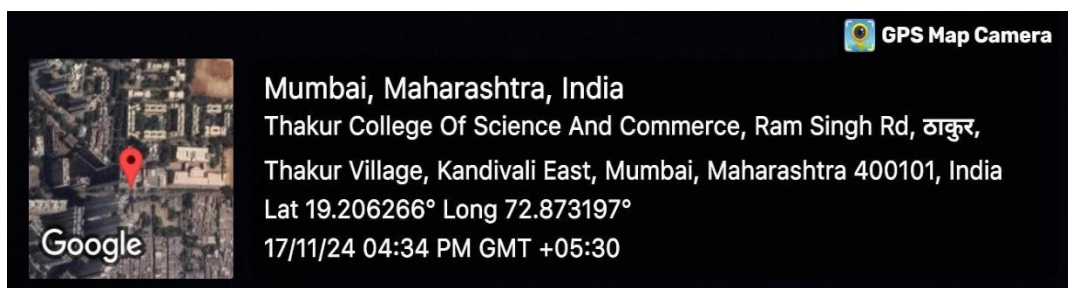
Report on GARBA NIGHT DAY 2

Venue :- Thakur College

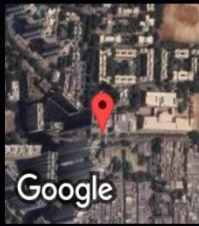
Summary of the Event :-

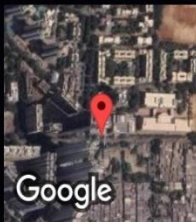
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REPORT OF FARREY PROMOTIONAL EVENT

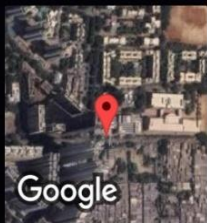

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Report on Trishna

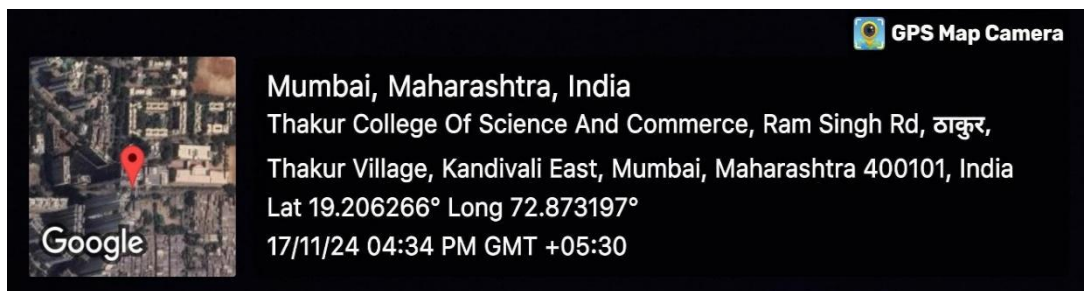
