9. Discussion on CEP / OJT for Semester IV, V & VI of NEP 2020:

This agenda point required to be discussed with the industry people and since there was no member present from the Industry, the Principal suggested to have a separate meeting with the members from the Industry for the deliberation on this point.

10. Approval of any changes made in the Course Curriculum:

1) Changes in the Curriculum of Indian Knowledge System in lieu with the **Curriculum of the University of Mumbai:**

Module 1: 10 Hours

Introduction to IKS – General Information about Ancient India

Module 2: 10 Hours Importance of IKS

Module 3: Subject Specific: 10 Hours

Aligned with the Major Subject

2) Changes in the curriculum of AEC (Hindi):

As some of the Non Hindi Learners were facing problems in the curriculum of Hindi, They can adapt to verbal skills but facing difficulty in the written skills. Hence, the BOS of AEC has suggested to divide the syllabus for them into modules, whereby primary and secondary levels can be decided and their spoken skills can be tested with some written skills rather than focusing completely on the written skills in the form of test or examination.

3) Changes in the Departmental Curriculum or Pattern:

a) Economics

Consideration of Department of Economics Students' Club in Co-Curricular

The Department of Economics would like to add Dé Planning Forum as Student Based activity under Co-Curricular Course at First Year level from next Academic Year 2025-2026. The department intends to continue its present activities under the Forum and also include student outreach-based activities and community research-based activities. In the BOS meeting, the members suggested to prepare a year plan for discussion in the next meeting but the college management can add it as an option accordingly if permitted by Academic Council and College Management.

Consideration of Change in Assessment Pattern for Economics

While discussing evaluation pattern, the members suggested to consider activity-based evaluation for the Science Students for the subjects of Principles of Economics and Introduction to Banking and Finance. The Members suggested to consider the pointer with College Management regarding the same.

b) M.Com. (E-Commerce)

Consideration of Practical Exam for Practical Subjects

4 credit practical subjects like Digital Marketing, Web Development will have Practical exam of 50 marks and written exam for 50 marks.

Computer Application in business (2 credits) will have no written exam but practical exam.

c) Environmental Studies

Consideration of Assignments for Internal Assessment

The BOS suggested that instead of traditional written tests, learners can be given written assignments focusing on local, regional and global issues.

Addition of the topic on Water Conservation in Sem II

As per UGC Guidelines the BOS approved the addition of topic on Water Conservation in Unit I of Environmental Education in Sem II.

d) B.Sc. (Interior Design)

The Structure of the Program has been changed to be more practical oriented as per the need of the Program.

Under AEC Course, Sem III & Sem IV, French I & French II have been replaced with Hindi I & Hindi II as per the State Government Guidelines for AEC.

e) Bachelor of Sports Management

Under AEC Course, Sem III & Sem IV, Spanish I & Spanish II have been replaced with Hindi I & Hindi II as per the State Government Guidelines for AEC.

f) Change in the Evaluation Pattern from 75:25 to 60:40 at SY Level for Programs under School of Computational Science & Technology

The School of Computational Science & Technology has proposed the change in Evaluation Pattern from 75:25 to 60:40 at SY Level from the A.C. Year 2024-2025 for B.Sc. (Information Technology), B.Sc. (Computer Science) & B.Sc. (Data Science).

Resolution: "It was resolved to approve the above changes."

11. Approval of Eligibility and Lateral Entry for the program:

Eligibility of the Program:

The Eligibility of all the programs as approved by the respective Board of Studies is approved by the Council.

Lateral Entry:

While admitting any student as the Lateral Entry; subjects / courses and credits earned would be mapped by the Equivalence Committee comprising of Vice Principals, Deans, COE and Head / Coordinator / Senior Faculty of the concerned Department and required measures would be taken to fulfil the requirements.

Resolution: "It was resolved to approve the eligibility and lateral entry norms, as per respective Board of Studies, University and College guidelines and designated committees in the college."

12. Any Other Matter with permission from the Chair:

No other matter was discussed.
