### **1. Confirmation of Minutes of the 11<sup>th</sup> Meeting held on 17<sup>th</sup> March 2022:**

### **2. Action taken report:**

- Thakur College of Science & Commerce (TCSC) organized the “Thakur Awards for Excellence” at a glittering function at the LaLit Hotel on Sunday 27<sup>th</sup> March 2022.

The event was organized as part of the Silver Jubilee Celebrations. Prof. Suhas Pednekar, Hon. Vice Chancellor, University of Mumbai was the Chief Guest and Mr.

Sudhir Puranik, Registrar & I/C Director, NSS, University of Mumbai was the Guest of Honour for the function.

A total of 24 distinguished achievers from across the country were awarded in the ceremony. Dr. Naresh Chandra, Former Pro-Vice Chancellor University of Mumbai and Director (Education), B.K. Birla College (Autonomous), Kalyan, Dr. Tukaram A. Shiware, Director of Education, Hinduja Foundation and Institute of Management, Mumbai and Dr. (Mrs.) Ancy Jose, Director, MKES Group of Institutes and former Principal of Nagindas Khandwala College (Autonomous) were awarded the Lifetime Achievement Award for their contributions as a teacher, mentor and leader whose credible contribution and dedicated service in the field of education is an inspiration for all.

To commemorate the event, a special edition coffee-table book "Reflections" was released by the dignitaries.

- The objection raised by CDC member Mr. Sunil Mantri regarding “charging of Rs. 50 per day as a Penalty for late fees on the learners” is under consideration and will be discussed in the upcoming Finance committee meeting.
- The plan to start M.Sc. in Aviation, Biotech and Physics is dropped.
- B.Com (Digital Business) is started in the academic year 2022-23. The number of learners Admitted is 55. 1<sup>st</sup> BOS Meeting was conducted on 28th February 2022. Details are already discussed in the previous CDC meeting.
- The annual Alumni Association Meet was organized on 7<sup>th</sup> May 2022 in the college auditorium. This was addressed by college principal Dr. C. T. Chakraborty and IQAC coordinator Dr. S. K. Singh. New Intubation Centre was inaugurated by the Principal, IQAC Coordinator, and the Alumni. During meeting, new alumni association and membership site was introduced to all the past and new members of the association. This was followed by the cultural programme, introduction of the members, and discussion related to the development of the college. Total of 117 alumni participated in the event.

  - Already conducted a 7 day Faculty Development Programme (FDP) on “Education in 21<sup>st</sup> Century: Implementing NEP 2020 for Quality Education in HEIs” in association with Guru Angad Dev Teaching Learning Centre, Delhi University under PMMMNMTT of Ministry of Education, Government of India from 9th to 16th August 2022 by Online Mode.
- To introduce new value-added / Career Oriented programmes. (PG Diploma, Advanced Diploma, Certificate Course, Interdisciplinary, Innovative).
- Flexibility of the Curriculum: CBCS/Core/Elective option / Open options.
  - Dr. Farooqui suggested to introduce Multidisciplinary courses e.g. to introduce Financial Analysis for Science Students by Financial Depts. Or Market Analysis by Commerce Dept. to give Curriculum flexibility to the learners.
- To Plan for beautification of Lobby and Toilets.
- To plan for Air Conditions in Class Room.
  - The plan has already been initiated.

- It was suggested to motivate students to register for placements.


## **13. Students & Teachers' Achievement:**
