8. ATKT Rules under NEP 2020:

The Examination & ATKT Rules under NEP 2020 was presented before the members for their approval:

ATKT Rules under NEP 2020 w. e. f. Academic Year 2023 - 2024

- Total credits need to be earned by the learner to achieve degree at under graduate level is 132 for Science, Commerce and Arts.
- Total credits to be earned by the learner for the degree at the post graduate level are 96.
- All the examinations at the First Year, Second Year and Third Year levels in Arts, Science and Commerce will be conducted by TCSC [Autonomous].
- The details regarding the examinations conducted by the college will be displayed, as and when required on the examination notice boards as well as the college website.
- Promotion of the learner to the Second Year and Third Year levels will be on the basis of the performance at the First Year and Second Year examinations respectively.

Credit Based Evaluation Scheme of Examinations (For UG and PG): The performance of the learners in two components will be evaluated for Semester I and II:

- First component will be the Internal Assessment (IA) carrying 25% marks of the overall marks for UG & 40% Marks for PG conducted by the Head / Coordinator of the respective programme / department of TCSC [Autonomous].
- Second component will be the semester wise Semester End Examination (SEE) carrying 75% marks of the overall marks for UG & 60% marks for PG conducted by the Controller of Examinations of TCSC [Autonomous].

The semester wise Credit Points may vary from programme to programme but the total credits to be earned by student to degree at undergraduate level and degree at postgraduate level shall be as follows:

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Passing Standards:

• The passing standards of the examination, eligibility criteria, rules for gracing of the marks and provision of A.T.K.T. (Allowed to Keep Terms) will be as per the stated Examination Policy of the Thakur College of Science & Commerce (Autonomous).

Passing Criteria:

- To pass in a particular course, learners have to obtain minimum 40% marks in the internal and external examinations separately for each course.
- For the Faculty of Science, there will be separate heads of passing for the theory examination and practical examination.
- Eligibility criteria for the admission to all the Under Graduate Programmes (aided and non-aided) in the Faculty of Arts and Faculty of Commerce under Credit Based Semester and Grading System will be as follows:

Rules for Allowed to Keep Terms (ATKT):

- A learner shall be allowed to keep term for Semester II irrespective of number of heads of failure in the Semester I.
- A learner shall be allowed to keep term for Semester III if,
 - 1) The learner has passed each semester I and semester II (OR)
 - 2) The learner fails in not more than 8 credits or 200 marks out of total marks of 550 per Semester.
- A learner shall be allowed to keep term for Semester IV irrespective of the grades obtained in each course of the Semester III.
- A student shall be allowed to keep term for Semester- V if,
 - 1) The learner passes in each semester I, II, III and IV

(OR)

2) The learner passes semester I and II but fails in not more than 8 credits or 200 marks in each semester III and / or IV where the maximum total marks for the semester is 550.

(OR)

3) The learner passes semester III and IV but fails in not more 8 credits or 200 marks in each semester I and II where the maximum total marks for the semester is 550.



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• A student shall be allowed to keep term for Semester VI irrespective of grades obtained in each course of Semester V.

Ordinances and Statutes under NEP 2020:

Under NEP 2020, the existing ordinance of 0.229 will not be applicable. The other ordinances viz. 0.5442, 0.5443, 0.5445 will be as per the standards given by the Parent University.

- ➤ Members suggested as follows:
 - To keep the 50 + 50 (Internal + External) pattern of evaluation.
 - Passing criteria should be different as per the capacity of the program.
 - Passing should be combined for Internal & External Examinations
