1. Confirmation of Minutes of the 17th meeting held on 02.05.2024:

2. Approval of the Academic Calendar for Term-I of the Academic Year 2024-2025:

The approval of the Academic Calendar for Term-I placed before the members, was approved unanimously.

3. Results of the Even Semesters of UG & PG for the A.C. Year 2023-2024:

The results of Sem II, IV & VI was presented before the members. It was noticed that the implementation of NEP affected the Result of Sem II; mainly the Co-curricular Course as many students failed in this course.

4. Provision of Seed Money for Pilot Projects in the College to strengthen the research:

The members were informed about the proposal of promoting the research environment in the college by providing seed money for the Pilot Projects

To meet the objective multidisciplinary research project proposals have been invited from faculty members of various departments of science and commerce streams.

The proposals will be evaluated by the scrutiny committee of external members so as to sanction the seed money.

6. Admissions of the International Students for A.C. Year 2024-2025:

7. Registration for ABC Ids & uploading data on NAD Portal:

The members were informed about the Statistics of ABC Registration of the students enrolled in the A.C. Year 2023-2024 as follows:

8. NAAC Reforms in Accreditation: Binary and MBGL & Submission of AQAR / SSR:
Members were informed about the NAAC Reforms in Accreditation i.e. Binary & MBGL.

The Binary method is likely to launch by September 2024 & MBGL may get launched by February 2025. If the college wishes to go for MBGL, it has a grace period of 3 months for the validity of Accreditation after the launch of MBGL.

The Certificate Courses proposed for the A.C. Year 2024-2025, presented before the members were approved.

Members were briefed about the major events organized by the College during last three months:


