APPLICATION PROCESS

Step 1	Speak to your Department Coordinator about applying for UFV's BCIS program
Step 2	Register for and complete years 1 and 2 of the BSc. of Information Technology or Computer Science from partner college with a "B" average (3.00/4.33 scale): comparable to first Class/Division standing AND grade 12th Math minimum 41.
Step 3	Register with Computrain and Complete the UFV application form and submit all required documents (see UFV Application Document Checklist) Application Deadline: Fall (September) Intake: 1st April Winter(January) Intake: 31st October
Step 4	Receive your UFV offer for BCIS program at UFV
Step 5	Pay first year fees AND Apply for your visa
Step 6	Make accommodation arrangements and book your ticket!
Step 7	Starting date of class is in 1 st week of September / 1 st week January
