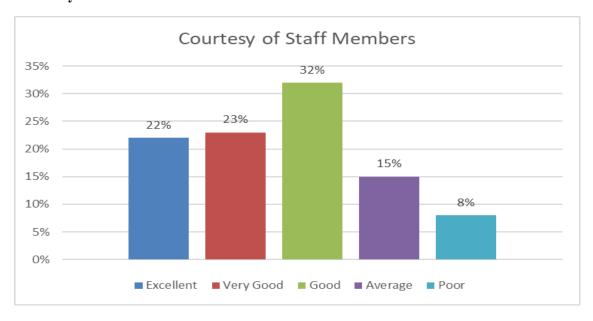

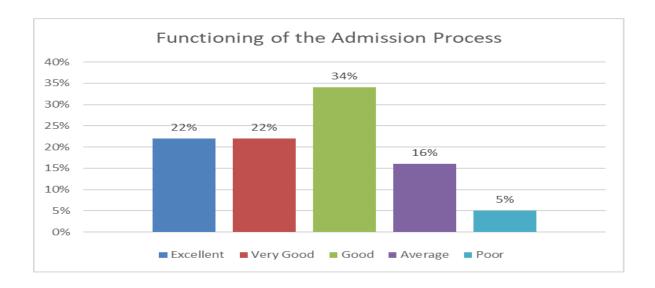

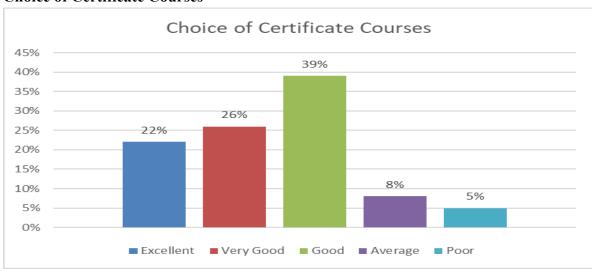

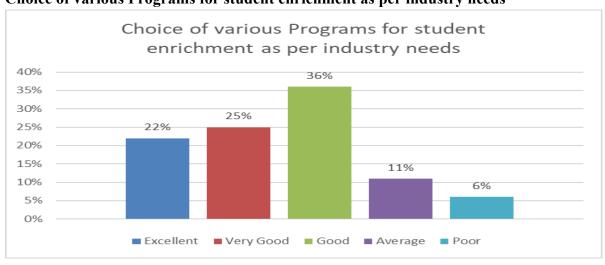
Functioning of the Admission Process



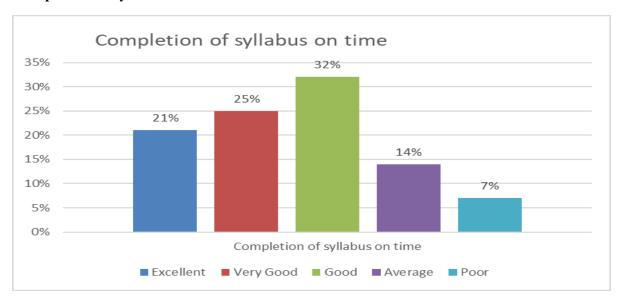

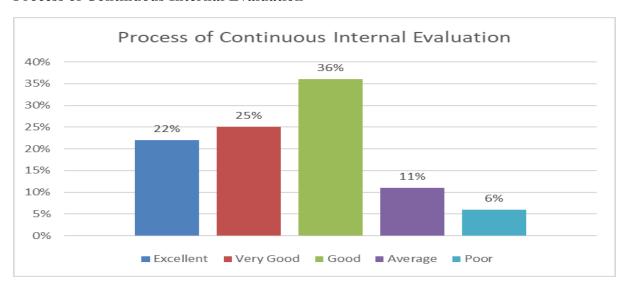

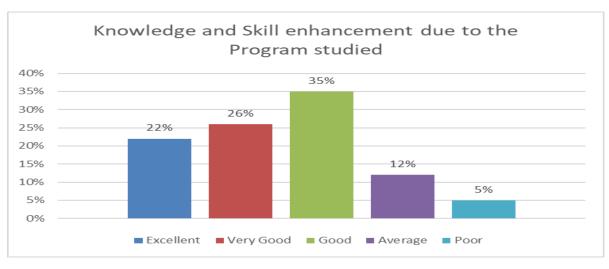

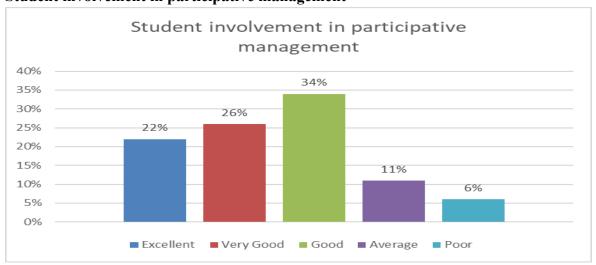

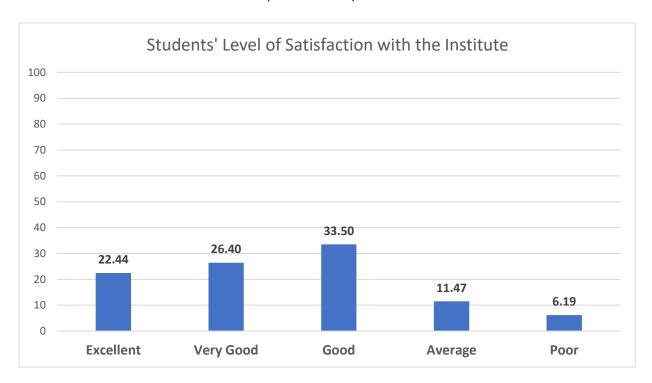
